Join the first Hybrid Juris Doctor (JD) Program in the US with a focus on Intellectual Property, Technology, and Information Law, and earn your JD primarily online with only minimal in-person commitments.

Innovative online instruction and coursework includes:

- live and pre-recorded video lectures
- reading and writing assignments

- virtual office hours and 1-to-1 real-time engagement opportunities with faculty and fellow students

International applicants looking to add to their résumé or practice law in the US are encouraged to apply to the mostly online Hybrid JD program.

International applicants are required to submit the following:

- e-Application through LSAC.org
- LSAT or GRE score
- Proof of English language proficiency (TOEFL/IELTS)
- Personal statement
- Additional statement of your interest in Intellectual Property
- 2-3 letters of recommendation
- Transcript(s)
- Résumé
